Heavy RainTM and Beyond: Two SoulsTM will be released in their full versions on June 18th, 2020 for 19.90 each. Detroit: Become HumanTM will be available in its full version on the very same day, for 39.90.

During its live stream, Quantic Dream revealed a collector's edition of Detroit: Become Human[™] on PC containing an exclusive set of 3 pins of the main characters of the game, as well as a new 27 cm statue of the Android «Kara», arranged on a base illuminated by a halo of LED lights, with integrated movable robot arms. Quantic Dream also announced during its live stream the opening of its official online store, https://shop.quanticdream.com/. Fans can now order a selection of articles branded with Quantic Dream studio branding and from its video game brands. The e-shop is currently shipping only in the EU, and will be available to the rest of the world in the coming months.

Quantic Dream is a French video game studio that has gained international recognition for the quality of its games. Founded in 1997 in Paris by David Cage, the studio innovates both in the field of artistic and technical domains, to create original interactive experiences based on emotions. Quantic Dream is the inventor of the «Interactive Drama» format, which allows players to change the course of a story through multiple choices, and to face the consequences. FahrenheitTM (aka Indigo Prophecy in North America) is the first game released in this format (2005), followed by three blockbusters developed in partnership with Sony Interactive Entertainment: Heavy RainTM (2010) Beyond: Two SoulsTM (2013) and Detroit: Become HumanTM (2018). These video games, entirely designed and produced by Quantic Dream, have won more than 250 awards worldwide and have made a significant contribution to the evolution of storytelling in video games. Over the years, Quantic Dream has collaborated with world-renowned talents such as David Bowie, Hans Zimmer, Ellen Page, Willem Dafoe, Clancy Brown or Jesse Williams. The studio has developed exclusive technologies and original franchises since its creation with the support of millions of players worldwide. Since 2019, Quantic Dream is also a video game publisher.
